### FUEL THEFT

Fuel thefts continue to be an issue across the country and in the central belt, Fife, Dundee and Angus areas in particular.

Below are a note of the incidents and where they happened along with their crime report number;

PS-20230106-0688 Callander vandalism to plant and theft of diesel. Welfare unit also broken into.

# THEFTS AND DAMAGE TO PLANT AND MACHINERY

Theft and damage to plant and machinery can be particularly disruptive and expensive.

Blackridge, West Lothian Clips on fencing removed and breaker which was on a trailer, stolen.

Persons u/k have accessed diggers, started them moved them around damaging the diggers and fences and other structures.
